

Safe Operating Procedure

Glue Mixer



PERSONAL SAFETY



PRE OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Ensure this power tool has a suitable safe work area;
- Examine the power lead and plug for obvious damage;
- Check that the glue mixer is correctly fitted;
- Check that machine is correctly tested and tagged.

POTENTIAL HAZARDS

- Moving and Rotating Parts;
- Airborne dust;
- Eye injuries;
- Electrical components.

OPERATIONAL SAFETY PRACTICES (CONTROLS)

- Do not connect to power source until all adjustments have been made;
- Check that the power lead does not create a trip hazard;
- Select the correct mixer and ensure that it is secured tightly;
- The mixer must be held firmly with both hands to control operational accuracy and the rotational torque;
- Keep hands and fingers well clear of moving parts. Avoid blocking & covering the motor ventilation slots with your hands;
- Allow the mixer to reach operating speed, then insert gradually. Do not apply excessive force;
- Avoid prolonged use as this could overheat the motor. Turn off after use. Do not place the mixer down until it has stopped rotating.

HOUSEKEEPING

- Remove mixer & return tool to the storage;
- Leave the work area in a safe, clean, & tidy condition.
